Preface

Surabhi Educational Society was set up with an objective to establish, aid and maintain educational institutions of high standards and impart education in Fine Arts, Pharmacy and Architechture. The college has grown strength to strength since then and the society was successful in establishing a post graduate program (M.Pharm-2years) in Pharmaceutics in the academic year 2004-2005. After MOU with the highly reputed Apollo Hospitals, Hyderabad, Pharm D program of 6 years was commenced in the year 2008 -2009 followed by a Pharm D post Baccalaureate (3 years) in 2009- 2010. Yet another addition M.Pharm in Pharmaceutical Analysis and Quality Assurance is made to this list in this year 2011-2012. Our college has also added a new feather in its cap by successful opening of Sri Venkateshwara Research Center for Ph.D students thus catering quality pharmacy education from Diploma to Ph.D.

Introduction

Sri Venkateshwara College of Pharmacy imparts education of high standards in all the pharmacy programs starting from Diploma to PhD. B. Pharmacy

The bachelor degree is open to all those who have completed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent exam with either M.P.C/Bi.P.C. group.



M. Pharmacy

M.Pharmacy is offered in pharmaceutics and pharmaceutical analysis & quality assurance as specializations. M.Pharmacy is a two year post graduation program comprising of four semesters. The first two semesters have regular academic teaching schedule. The last two semesters involve project work and thesis submission. The projects involving newer



research areas are being carried out year after year in our laboratories. Students are also encouraged to travel across the country to present their research works in various conferences. The research collaborations with reputed institutes and industries like IICT, DRL, Aurobindo, Hetero etc. are highly encouraged. The students of M.Pharmacy have achieved many laurels for the college and had good placements since inception of the course.

Pharm, D

The Doctor of Pharmacy is a six year professional program. The Pharm.D program emphasizes an integrated and problem-based approach to disease state management. The first five years will include both theory and practicals in subjects such as Human Anatomy and Physiology, Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical chemistry, Analysis, Pharmaceutical Microbiology, Pharmacology, Pharmacotherapy, Clinical Pharmacy, Biochemistry,



Community pharmacy, Biostatistics, Pharmacoeconomics, Clinical Toxicology and Clinical research. The sixth year consists of internship involving postings in specialty units in the hospital. It is a phase of training wherein a student is exposed to actual pharmacy practice and clinical pharmacy services and acquires skill under supervision so that the student becomes capable of functioning independently as a clinical pharmacist.

Post Baccalaureate Pharm, D

It is a three year program and is aimed at providing an opportunity to the B.Pharm graduates to acquire the Pharm.D degree. This program provides the students with real world experience necessary to understand and meet the challenges in the health care community.





D. Pharmacy

The candidates seeking admission into diploma of pharmacy should qualify the entrance exam conducted by the State Board of Technical Education, Andhra Pradesh.

Research Centre

Sri Venkateshwara Research Center was established to cater to the students pursuing their PhD program in Pharmacy and selected by the Osmania University as per the eligibility criteria and university guidelines. The college provides adequate lab and other infrastructural facilities for these students. The



center also undertakes projects from industries and academic institutions in Pharmaceutical technology, Formulation Research, Pharmacodynamics and Pharmacokinetics.
